SYSTEMS

All ABF events are subject to the ABF Systems Regulations as revised to **June 2008**; a copy is available upon application to the Tournament Organiser.

Systems permitted in the Roger Penny Senior Swiss Pairs and the Australian Swiss Pairs Championship are GREEN, BLUE and RED. Pairs in any doubt about the classification of their system should submit details in advance to the Tournament Organiser. BROWN STICKER conventions are permitted subject to full disclosure and compliance with the "protected pair" regulation.

Written defences to BROWN STICKER Conventions, subject to approval by a Director, are permitted at the table.

PLAYOFF QUALIFYING POINTS (PQP) are awarded according to ABF Regulations to players who have attested their eligibility.

♦ **PLAYOFF.** Detailed information about PQP and the mode of entry to the Playoff for Australian team selection is available on the ABF website at: (hyperlink <http://www.abf.com.au>) www.abf.com.au. It is mailed only on receipt of a written request.

THE REGULATING AUTHORITIES (The Australian Bridge Federation & The Tasmanian Bridge Association) reserve the right to refuse admission to any player who is not in good standing with any registered bridge club, bridge association or the Regulating Authority.

♦ Players under the age of 25 who provide proof are entitled to a 50% discount.
