The TBA Committee met at the TBA on Tuesday March 8th from 3.30pm.

The following matters were discussed:

### **Tasmanian Festival of Bridge**

There is still time to enter our annual premier bridge event which kicks off in Launceston on March  $24^{th}$  and runs for four days -2 x two day events. As per ABF regulations, you will be required to show proof of vaccination on Thursday and Saturday mornings, prior to participating in the two events. We will need help to pack up tables, bidding boards and other equipment at the TBA on Wednesday March  $23^{rd}$  after the morning session, and also on Monday morning March  $28^{th}$  to unpack everything and restore the club to operating capability.

### TBA sessions cancelled during TFoB

The TBA clubrooms will be closed during the Tasmanian Festival of Bridge, from the evening of Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> March to Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> March. The regular TBA sessions during this time will be cancelled. This includes Wednesday Evening Supervised, Thursday Morning, Thursday Afternoon, Friday Morning and Saturday Afternoon. This also impacts the Hobart City Bridge Club on the evening of Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> March. Regular sessions will resume on Monday 28<sup>th</sup> March.

#### **COVID-19 Safety Plan – Increased distance between tables**

With mandatory public health restrictions easing, the Committee will recommend to Directors that whenever possible, windows are open and that playing tables for each session be as widely spaced as possible. This will not only have the benefit of increased ventilation and increased social distancing, but will also prevent the transmission of information about hands during any post mortems at the table.

# **Surcharge for Red Masterpoints Removed**

Since many members now pay their table money by voucher rather than cash it is inconvenient when required to pay that extra dollar for red master point events. After a cost benefit analysis by Malcolm Sherlock (our Masterpoints Secretary) we have decided to scrap the masterpoint surcharge, effective immediately.
