



System Cards

Introduction

System Cards provide bridge partnerships and opponents with a clear outline of the bidding system being used. It is a general expectation that at most bridge events players should have a system card with them.

Purpose

This policy outlines the TBA's policy around the use of System Cards at TBA bridge events

Scope

This policy applies to most TBA bridge events. The exception is supervised sessions.

Policy

- For all non-supervised bridge events players must have a current System Card with them at the table.
- All walk in players **MUST** have their System Card with them so the partner they are linked up with has an understanding of their bidding system.
- For newer players a simple System Card (two sided) is acceptable.
- The TBA will make hard copy blank versions available for members. There is also a blank version available on the TBA website.
- Members needing assistance in completing their System Card may liaise with a Director.
