



Policy 7

National or State Representation – Financial Support

Introduction

Each year the State Tournament Advisory Committee recommends nine pairs to selected to represent Tasmania at the Australian National Congress. The TBA will provide some support to the State Team to assist them in participating the tournament. It is not intended to cover players cost but to contribute to support their attending.

Additionally, from time to time, TBA members are selected to be a part of the national team representing Australia on the international stage. TBA wants to provide some financial support to these people.

Purpose

This Policy provides the guidelines for calculating the amount of money that will be allocated to State or National Team members to assist them in attending the national or an international tournament.

Scope

This policy applies to all Tasmanian State Team members. The policy also applies to any TBA member who is representing the country.

Policy

The TBA will

- Provide \$120 per day of the tournament plus one extra day to support to each State Team Member
- Cover the cost of a reasonable return airfare to the location of the tournament
- Pay directly to the organising committee the cost of the formal dinner or other social event if the player is attending

These amounts may be reviewed by the Committee each annually.

- TBA members who are selected to play internationally will be given a subsidy to participate in the competition. The amount will be determined on a case-by-case basis.
